## FACILITATING SPARTAN READY GROUP MEETINGS

## Here are some tips for faclitating group meetings:

- Keep groups at eight student or fewer so that everyone has a chance to speak.
- Make sure to provie questions beforehand so that students come ready to discuss.
- Encourage students to share with a partner what they are learning at work and how it connects with academics.
- After partners have shared, have them report back to the group on what they talked about.

One person dominates the conversation  A student remains silent	<ul> <li>Acknowledge their contrubutions, but ask "What do others think?"</li> <li>Call on other individuals to speak</li> <li>Use a round-robin format so that each person gets to share</li> <li>Ask in a non-pressuring way if they would</li> </ul>

A student keeps taking conversations to a negative place	<ul> <li>Acknowledge their frustrations and offer to follow up with them later</li> <li>Move on to others who are more interested in sharing.</li> </ul>
